# **Overall upturn in results**

- Higher results across most metrics
- Overall performance increased by three points
- Reputation benchmark increased and remains acceptable
- Champions increased and Sceptics decreased
- Perception of quality of life remains high
- Community spirit is increasing
- Indication of improvement in trust and Council activity

- Prioritise spending on core infrastructure
- Concerns over growth and the affect on communities
- Concerns about high rates
- Provision of a wider range of waste services
- Demographic differences
- Many positive comments
